

## Music rooms & Band room terms of use

### Purpose

The music rooms are a service of the VSETH and are available for all authorised users as a musical complement to their studies or work.

### Authorised users

The music rooms are first and foremost for the students from ETH. Secondly ETH employees, students from University Zurich and external users can profit from the music rooms. Usage of the music rooms for commercial reasons (e.g. music classes) is not allowed. By violating the terms of use the authorisation to use the music rooms will be deducted.

### Inventory

The users of the music rooms are obligated to handle the instruments and equipment with care. Don't put any objects on the pianos or the grand pianos, nor leave them in the sun. The technical equipment in the band room (room no. 5.2) must be protected from extreme temperatures and liquids. If an instrument or equipment is damaged please inform VSETH immediately (Tel: 044 632 42 98 or [musikzimmer@vseth.ethz.ch](mailto:musikzimmer@vseth.ethz.ch)) with description of damage and the room number.

The technical equipment in the band room should only be operated by experienced persons. The instructions manual of the equipment should be absolutely followed. The existing wiring should not be changed or removed. A box with accessories (microphone, DI-boxes, instruments and XLR cables) can be borrowed from the technical supervisor Joram Schito, [jschito@ethz.ch](mailto:jschito@ethz.ch). The person borrowing the box is responsible for the complete and undamaged return of the box. Missing or damaged equipment must be reported immediately.

### Sound volume

Playing loud instruments is generally not allowed (acoustic drums, bagpipe, e-guitar etc.). The usage of the amplifier and the loudspeakers in the band room is allowed on week days from 6pm till midnight and on the weekends from 7am till midnight.

### Tidiness

All users have to leave the music rooms clean and tidy. In addition eating and drinking is not allowed. Music stands and chairs have to be put back into the room where they were taken from. The inventory of the band room (e-drums, microphone stands, instrument racks, mixers, amplifiers, loudspeakers and holders) must not be removed from the room.

### Fees

An inscription fee will be charged every 6 months for which the music rooms are used. The price of the fee can be found on the price list. The fee starts upon use of the music room and accounts for 6 months independent of the exact starting date. After the 6 months have passed, the next

inscription fee will be due from the next usage. In addition to the inscription fee, every booked hour will be charged separately as listed on the price list. The invoices are sent via e-mail every half calendar year and fall due for payment within a month. For every dunning letter, 15 CHF will be charged additionally. Access to the music room can be denied if usage fees are overdue. The deposit will be locked until the settlement of the account.

### Access to music room

Every registered user receives a badge for the access to the music rooms(deposit CHF 50.00). The deposit will be refunded when the badge is returned. The badge can be collected at the VSETH secretariat.

### Access to building

After 8.00 pm or at the weekends the users of the music rooms at Höggerberg can have access to the building HPI with their Legi.
